Eighth Grade Field Trips Policy for Eligibility and Permission Slip

1st and 2nd Quarter PBIS:

Eighth grade students are rewarded for good behavior throughout the year. At the end of the first quarter, there may be a local trip to the movies/bowling alley. At the end of the second quarter, there may be a local trip to the movies/bowling alley. To be eligible for these trips, students must meet the following requirements:

- No more than one offense resulting in a detention or AE during the quarter
- No suspensions during the quarter
- No physical aggression or severe cases of disrespect resulting in AE
- Passing all classes including physical education

3rd and 4th Quarter PBIS:

A trip <u>may</u> be taken at the end of the fourth quarter. In the past, we have taken a trip to Holiday World but that trip is dependent upon student behavior throughout the year. To be eligible for this trip, students must meet the following requirements:

- No suspensions during any quarter
- No more than two offenses resulting in detention or AE during each quarter
- No physical aggression or severe cases of disrespect resulting in AE
- Passing all classes including physical education during 3rd and 4th quarter
- AR goal is met during the 3rd and 4th guarter

While it is our goal to take all students on field trips, **students do not have a right to attend. Field trips are a privilege that must be earned by students.** Eighth grade teachers reserve the right to refuse to taken any student not these trips whose behavior during school hours has been cause for concern during the school year regardless of whether or not the student received disciplinary action for his or her behavior.

Rather than burden parents with a permission slip every time we take a field trip, we are requesting that parents sign one permission slip at the beginning of the year. This permission slip will cover all field trips taken by eighth grade students including walking trips and trips by bus. You will receive information prior to each trip advising you of the date, time, location, means of transportation, and cost, if any, of the upcoming trip. You may notify us at the time if you do not wish for your child to attend a particular trip. Please read the above policy, sign below and return to Mrs. Schmitt on or before **Wednesday**, **August 23**. **Failure to return this slip will result in ineligibility for all field trips**.
